Rosh Hashanah: Shofar So Good

Leviticus 23:23-32, 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

ROSH HASHANAH: THE FEAST OF TRUMPETS

One of the High Holy Days in the Bible

Rosh means HEAD and Hashanah means NEW YEAR

Similar to “New Year”

September 29, 2019 Sundown to Tuesday, October 1

Begins ten days of reflection and repentance leading up to

YOM KIPPUR, THE DAY OF ATONEMENT

Shofar is curved ram’s horn symbolizing BENT, HUMILITY

ROSH HASHANAH: A CALL TO HOLY ASSEMBLY

REMEMBER who God is and who you are

REFLECT on your life and your purpose

REPENT from your sins and shortcomings

REJOICE in God’s grace and mercy

SOUND THE SHOFAR—IT IS TIME TO CHANGE

1. Tekiah: One long steady blast

Acknowledge God as CREATOR and KING

* Psalm 24

* Psalm 139:1-14

Prayers of PRAISE and ADORATION

2. Shevarim: Three short blasts

Represents our BROKENNESS; that we have LOST OUR WAY (Luke 19:10)

* Isaiah 53:6

* Psalm 51:1-4

Calls for prayers of CONFESSION

3. Ter'uah: nine short, smaller sounds

Represents tears of a **BROKEN, CONTRITE HEART**

* Psalm 51:14-17

* Isaiah 25:8-9

Calls for prayers of **REPENTANCE** and **CHANGE**

4. Tekiah-gedolah: one long, 10 second blast

Represents **FORGIVENESS, REBIRTH, RENEWAL**

* Micah 7:18-19

Calls for prayers of **THANKSGIVING** and **REJOICING**

SHANA TOVA AND OTHER BLESSINGS

1. *"Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one. Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength."* Deuteronomy 6:4-5
2. Love your neighbor as you love yourself. (Jesus)
3. Do acts of **KINDNESS** and **CHARITY**
4. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem (Psalm 122:6)
